

Santa Clara County Requirements for Placement in an RCL 10/11 Wraparound Service

To be eligible for referral and placement in RCL 10/11 Wraparound services, a youth must:

1. Be a Dependent Child or a Ward of the Juvenile Court in Santa Clara County.
2. Be under the age of 18.
3. Be placed in or at are risk of placement in an RCL 10/11 group home as determined by the referring agency.
4. Have a referring agency approved place to reside in the community with a parent, relative caregiver, or foster parent who has agreed to participate in a Wraparound program, or a child currently residing in the Children's Shelter with placement opportunities being explored.
5. Have Court agreement that RCL 10/11 services are appropriate, including CCF orders if necessary.
6. Not able to meet all the criteria for RCL 12/13/14 Wraparound services

Children referred for 10/11 Wraparound Services typically exhibit one or more of the following:

- Frequent running away
- Substance use disorder
- Attachment disorder
- Developmental disorder
- Adjustment disorder
- Posttraumatic stress disorder
- Aggressive disorder
- Minor criminal behavior
- Oppositional/defiant behavior
- School truancy problems
- Beyond control of parents and or other primary care adults

PLEASE NOTE: Once Wraparound services are approved, Wraparound placement must be approved by Juvenile Court for Dependent and Delinquent children.
