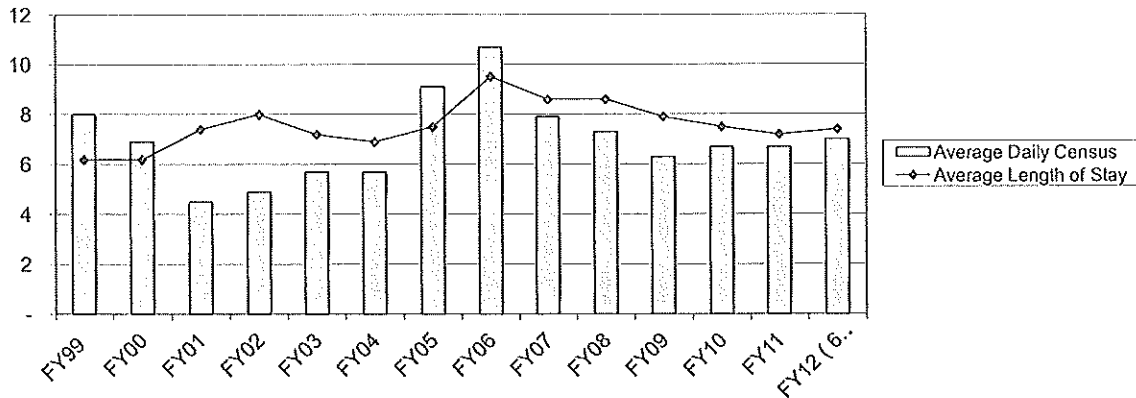

SCCMHD does not have an "in county" psychiatric inpatient unit for children and adolescents. We have contracted out services for inpatient care since about 1992.

We contract with 3 different hospitals to serve kids 4-17 years old.

- * St. Helena CBH in Vallejo serves 4-17 years old.
- * John Muir in Concord serves kids 4-17 years old.
- * Fremont Hospital in Fremont serves adolescents 12-17 years old.

- * Kids are admitted either by EPS or EMQ crisis.
- * The youngest kid seen in EPS in FY11 was 3 years old.
- * the youngest child hospitalized in FY11 was 7 years old.
- * SCCMHD has a Hospital Liaison who works with the hospitals on discharge planning.
- * Kids stay in the hospital for an average length of stay of 7 days.
