MAT services include the ordering, prescribing, administering and monitoring of all medications for SUD. Patients are screened and referred through the Gateway Central Screening and Referral Program. Upon completion of intake and admission, clients are assigned a primary counselor who coordinates treatment and provides case management services for needs beyond addictions treatment. This may include employment, housing, psychiatric or primary medical care.
