### Santa Clara Valley Health & Hospital System is a Smoke-Free Zone.

Smoking is not allowed on the Santa Clara Valley Medical Center campus, at Valley Health Centers, or at any County owned and operated facility where patient care is provided. The No-Smoking Zone applies to all areas inside and outside of buildings, and to all patients, clients, visitors, contractors and employees.
